HOW TO PREPARE BARE PLASTIC



DEGREASE

Thoroughly degrease the substrate with a water-based degreaser such as U-POL System 20 (S2000/5). This removes grease, dirt.



SAND

Abrade bare plastic with 180-240 grit.



ABRADE SURROUNDING AREA

Any hard to reach areas should be abraded by hand with a fine scuff pad.



DEGREASE AGAIN

Once abraded, blow off with compressed air and thoroughly degrease with water based degreaser.



WIPE WITH TACK RAG

Wipe the substrate with a tack rag.



APPLY RAPTOR

You are now ready to shoot RAPTOR.



TOP TIPS:



Masking is essential to eliminate the risk of overspray.



Use of solvent based degreaser can swell plastics.



Bare plastic or hard to abrade areas require 1-2 coats of RAPTOR Adhesio Promoter. It can be painted over after 20 mins.



If you are using the 2K RAPTOR Bed Liner, invert the can to clear the dip tupe in between coats.
