





HOW TO PREPARE PLASTIC WITH OEM PAINT ON



DEGREASE

Wash the surface to remove organic contaminants. Thoroughly degrease the substrate with a solvent-based degreaser such as U-POL WIPE#6 or System 20. This removes grease and dirt.



SAND Abrade the substrate with 180-320 grit.



ABRADE SURROUNDING AREA Any hard to reach areas should be abraded by hand with a red medium scuff pad.



DEGREASE AGAIN

Once abraded, blow off with compressed air and thoroughly degrease with water based degreaser.



WIPE WITH TACK RAG Wipe the substrate with a tack rag.



APPLY RAPTOR You are now ready to shoot RAPTOR.



TOP TIPS:



Masking is essential to eliminate the risk of overspray.



Use of solvent based degreaser car swell plastics.



Bare plastic or hard to abrade areas require 1-2 coats of RAPTOR Adhesion Promoter. It can be painted over after



If you are using the 2K RAPTOR Bed Liner, invert the can to clear the dip tupe in between coats.
